Dear Parents,

Did you know that Paseo Pointe gives bell to bell instruction? That means teachers begin instruction when the bell rings at 7:30am. We are committed to making the most of every minute your child is here at school. That is why it is important that students are on time and present each day.

In order to help encourage attendance, Paseo is rolling out new initiatives.

1. **Perfect Attendance:** We want to recognize students who are committed to being at school every day. Students with perfect attendance each month will receive a free dress down pass. Students that are dismissed before the end of the day will not be eligible for perfect attendance. Students who have been quarantined due to COVID-19 will be eligible for this award if they keep up on their classwork during quarantine!
2. **“Show Up, Rise Up!”** We know emergencies or sickness can keep students away. So we want to recognize those students who may not have perfect attendance but have shown great effort to be here as well. At the end of the quarter, students who have 3 or fewer excused absences will be a part of a celebration.
3. **Rams RISE:** It is important students are here ON TIME so they don't miss out on any instruction. Classes will begin to earn a letter each time their class has no tardies. That means, everyone is present at 7:30 am. Once they spell “Excellence,” they are able to earn a dress down day.
4. **Student ID:** Students wearing their ID is part of our school uniform. Students that enter campus without an ID starting January 3rd will check in through the front office
