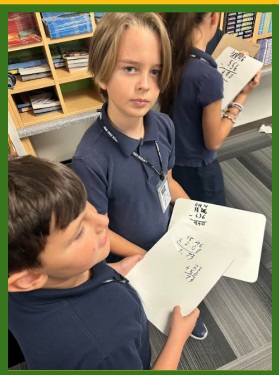
Dear Paseo Pointe Dual Language
